

Description of the Zienzele Night Sponsored Walk Around Occum Pond

On Wednesday May 24th, 2017 the Zienzele Foundation will hold its 17th annual fund raising event at the Dartmouth Outing Club on Occum Pond. As a part of this activity we will, for the first time, be having a fund raising sponsored walk around Occum Pond from 3pm until 6pm. This walk will commence at the Dartmouth Outing Club and proceed along Occum Ridge, turning left onto Clement Road and then returning to the Outing Club via Rope Ferry Road. We anticipate about sixty walkers traversing the one mile route perhaps multiple times. Along this route we will have five tables set up in different locations on the roadside shoulders to provide water to the walkers, via volunteers stationed at these tables, as well as the opportunity (via handouts) to learn about some of the villages we serve in Zimbabwe. We likewise anticipate that the walkers will range in age from teenagers to senior citizens. The map below shows the one mile walking route as well as the location of the five tables mentioned above. This walk will take place rain or shine.
