Collegiate fields are open only to full time collegiate students with valid USAC Collegiate licenses and full time high school students with valid USAC Junior licenses. Jerseys and bibs for all such riders must feature school names and/or logo, or be generic blank kits; non-scholastic club and trade team kits are not permitted. USA Cycling licenses available for sale on-site. Consult the ECCC website at <http://collegiatecycling.org/eccc> for more information on categories, eligibility, licensing, and other general questions.

Registration Fees: Team Time Trial - \$25/team, Individual Time Trial - \$10; Criterium - \$20; Road Race - \$25; Beginners Clinic - \$20.

Pre-Registration is available on-line at BikeReg.com, where service charges might apply. Registrations not received before 5pm on March 30th will incur a \$5 per rider per event late fee. Large ECCC Teams may submit a spreadsheet with the following information: Rider Name, USAC License Number, Race Category and Races being entered for each rider. This spreadsheet must be sent to eccc.road@gmail.com and received by March 30th at 5pm in order to avoid a \$5 late registration fee per rider per event.

Registration is located near finish line for all races. It opens 1 hour before the start of the first scheduled race and ends 15 minutes before the start of each race.

Promoter is not required to refund pre-registration in an event of an unforeseen cancellation.

Directions to ITT Start (GPS/Google Address - 9 Boathouse Rd, Hanover, NH):

- **From I-91 North or South:** Take Exit 13 for Norwich, VT / Hanover, NH. Turn on to S Main Street to drive east toward the Connecticut River. Cross the river on the Ledyard Bridge (Rt.10A) and make an immediate left turn in to the Ledyard Canoe Club parking area.
- **From 1-89 North or South:** Take the exit for 1-91 North. After 5 miles, take Exit 13 for Norwich, VT / Hanover, NH. See directions above.

Directions from ITT to Criterium Parking:

Turn left out of the parking area on to West Wheelock Street / Rt.10A. Drive up the hill and turn left at the second stop light (Park Street / Rt.120). At the next stop light, drive straight to enter Dewey Parking Lot.

Directions to TTT/Road Race Start (GPS/Google Address - 408 Hinesburg Rd, Charlotte, VT):

- **From east:** I-89 to Exit 12. VT 2A south to VT 116 south to Hinesburg. East on Charlotte Rd (3rd light in town - across from IGA Market) to school on left (approx 5 miles).
- **From west/south:** I-87 to Exit 28. NY 74 to Ticonderoga. North on NY 9N/22 to NY 185 east. Once over the bridge and in VT, bear left onto VT 17 west to Addison. North on VT 22A to Vergennes. North on US 7 to Church Hill Rd east (opposite direction of VT F-5). At stop, bear right onto Hinesburg Rd; school is on right.
- **From north:** I-89 to Exit 13. I-189 west to US 7 south. Take left at Church Hill Rd east (opposite direction of VT F-5). At stop, bear right onto Hinesburg Rd; school is on right.
