Changes for 2017:

Our remaining events (walk, golf, and row) will remain unchanged.







 - a. Age, sex, height, weight, hair color
 - b. Pertinent medical information
 - c. Prouty participant?...pull reg. info, bib number and emergency contact info
 - d. Determine point last seen, direction of travel, clothing worn
 4. Radio a missing person(s) advisory to include a description of the missing person(s) to all Prouty Area Captains on-site with an FRS Radios (17), including Parking and Shuttle volunteers. If found...escort directly to the information tent.
 5. Utilizing the public address sound system, announce advisory with description of the missing person(s), asking to report to the info tent.
 6. Containment of the school and venue...volunteers are to be sent to the main entry and exit points of both the school and field and tasked to watch for the missing person at these locations until told otherwise. With the exit and entry points posted, all tents should be searched to include the main portion of field. Interior of school will also be searched. Radio RMS. Janitorial Staff with radio at incident command to assist. All search updates should be brought to the attention of Bill Brown at the info tent.
