We wanted to let you know that the results from the chemical and radiological testing of the 25 soil samples collected during the recent August excavation came back negative. The laboratory reports can be found on the Rennie Farm website at <http://www.dartmouth.edu/~ehs/rennie.html>.

As we mentioned at the public information session last week, we have begun to compile a list of neighbors who lived in the Rennie Farm vicinity from the 1960s onward so that we can provide them with information regarding the burial site.
