Dear neighbors,

We held our first health advisory group meeting this week with Dr. Robert McLellan, section chief for occupational and environmental medicine at Dartmouth-Hitchcock. Based on that conversation, we invited Dr. McLellan to give a community presentation on 1,4-dioxane and health risk. He has agreed to present on Tuesday, November 1, from 7 to 9 pm in Filene Auditorium located in the Moore building on the Dartmouth College campus.

As promised, we have begun setting up meetings with property owners in the vicinity of Rennie Farm to talk about matters related to real estate. We know that some people have property for sale, some are trying to rent, and others are worried about what lies ahead. Because each property is unique and each owner will have specific questions and concerns, initially we are planning a personalized approach to meeting with property owners.
