Public Information Meeting Schedule

Dear Mrs. Rogalski:

The Department of Environmental Services (Department) has reviewed the above-referenced letter, which you recently submitted. The letter provides additional discussion of a number of issues relative to the on-going environmental investigations and cleanup of the Dartmouth College Rennie Farm site, as raised in your previous letter submitted to the Department on July 21, 2016. As indicated in our response letter of August 4, 2016, the Department remains committed to thoroughly considering each of the points raised in your letters as the Department completes its review of the relevant site-related submittals from Dartmouth and its environmental consultants.

In addition please note that, in response to your recent request for a public meeting, the Department will be hosting a public informational meeting at Dartmouth College (Alumni Hall) on September 13, 2016, starting at 6:00 pm. The Dartmouth College Alumni Hall is located in the Hopkins Center on the Dartmouth campus.

Scheduling of the public meeting follows the expected date for submittal of the Phase II Supplemental Hydrogeologic Investigation (approximately September 1, 2016), which is currently being prepared by Dartmouth's environmental consultants. As noted in our August 4, 2016 letter, that forthcoming report will include the data necessary to evaluate final remedial alternatives for the site, which are expected to include, at a minimum, additional source area excavation and groundwater extraction and treatment.
