

The Town of Hanover will be starting work on the 7 Lebanon Street Parking Garage on Monday, October 21st, 2019. The Town has contracted with Desman Design Management from Boston, MA and Structural Preservation Systems, LLC from Cheshire, CT to complete the work. The first phase of the renovation project will include demolition and repair of the pedestrian “plaza” area by the Lebanon Street entrance gate.

This work will close the top two uncovered levels of the garage, as well as level 2A due to the potential for falling debris in that area during demolition. It will also close the pedestrian stairs from Currier Street to through traffic and there will be no access to the garage from the stairwell or elevator on Level 2A. It is anticipated that work will be conducted Monday through Friday between 7:00 am and 5:00 pm and will be completed before Thanksgiving.

During this time, we will also be replacing the outdated garage access and gate system. Because of the impacts of the combined work, the garage will only be open to current lease and permit holders during this phase of construction. Access from Lebanon Street should remain open for delivery and service vehicles, but patrons of the garage should plan on using the South Street entrance to access parking. If the Lebanon Street access needs to be closed further notifications will be made.

One good option for short-term parking during the garage closure is Lot 7, adjacent to the Black Family Visual Arts Center on Lebanon Street (see map below).
